The Christmas Angel Dancer and Parent Performance Policies and Procedures

1. **Casting:** Many factors are considered when casting dancers. Technical ability, performance skills, in-class effort, consistency, application of notes, confidence, maturity, and, age all influence our decision. We are sensitive to each dancer's feelings that arise from the casting process. As a current Celestial Stars student, your year and specifically your recital performance and summer session are weighed along with your audition experience. Regardless of specific casting, we expect all members to work together as one team committed to pursuing excellence in dance.
2. **Attendance:** Arrive early for all rehearsals and come prepared to dance. You must be warmed up to prevent injury. If you arrive late to rehearsal you will be marked as ABSENT. The teachers try to stay on schedule, though there will be times when dancers and parents will have to wait. During performance week, no absences are allowed. It is imperative that you practice and remember your choreography.
3. **Absences:** All rehearsals are mandatory and you must adhere to the schedule. By being in this performance it must take priority in your schedule. Other activities that interfere will not be excused. If you have an emergency and must miss rehearsal, please call the studio at 803-939-1129. Any no show will result in your removal from the performance with no refunds given on donations and items purchased.
4. **Understudy:** An understudy position is required to attend all rehearsals and will be called upon if the dancer they are understudying is injured, ill, or otherwise unable to dance. A dancer may be moved to an understudy position at the staff's discretion if there are behavior issues, absences, etc.
5. **Schedules:** All performers and/or parents are required to download the Remind app. Rehearsal schedules will be posted on the bulletin, emailed, all updates/changes will be sent through Remind. It is your responsibility to know the schedule and to be aware of any changes. Rehearsals will be scheduled on Saturdays and week nights. Do not ask to be an exception to the schedule.
6. **Attire:** You must wear proper Ballet attire to all rehearsals, including hair in a slick bun. If you arrive not wearing the correct attire, you will be dismissed from rehearsal and you will be considered absent.
7. **Costumes:** Handle all costumes with respect and care. Do not sit in, play in, eat in, or drink in your costume. Only water is allowed. Do not take any costume home. If any damage is done to a costume/headpiece during rehearsals and performance, you are responsible for fixing it and/or replacing it. You will provide your own required stage make-up, earrings, hair accessories, and costume base such as shoes, tights, and leotards that will be ordered through the studio. Instructions will be given for hair and make-up. Please follow these instructions; the back-stage moms are not responsible for your child's hair and make-up. Remind your child to use the restroom before rehearsals and before getting into costumes.
8. **Workshops:** Workshops in acting, improv, stage hair/make-up, etc are provided and it is highly recommended that performers participate.
9. **Respect and Behavior:** Always be respectful to the artistic staff, crew, volunteers, peers, and parents. Dancers are to be on their best behavior at all times. Respect the property of others. Write your name in your belongings and do not pick up items that do not belong to you. Respect the facilities and locations where you dance. Throw away your trash. Pick up after yourself. Leave things clean and neat. Do not play in the rehearsals or interfere with those who are rehearsing. Older dancers are to remember they are role models for the younger dancers. They should demonstrate proper conduct in class, rehearsals, and be aware of the content you share on your social media pages as it is a reflection of your character. Younger dancers should respect the rights and privileges of the older and more experienced dancers. No food or drink may be taken into the studios, dressing rooms, theatre, or near costumes.
10. Parents and dancers: **NO TALKING** during rehearsals. No gossiping.
11. Parents and dancers: **NO CELL PHONES** allowed in any rehearsal. This includes parents in the audience. If you are going to sit in the theatre during rehearsals, do not be on your phone, it is prohibited to take any video and photos during rehearsals and performances.
12. **Parents** are required to financially support The Christmas Angel by donating at the minimum Birthstone Star level for each performer. If you are unable to make this financial commitment, your dancer can be sponsored through family, friends, and/or small businesses and it is your responsibility to make this happen. It is important that you seek sponsorships as a fundraising initiative (think your workplace, Dr's and Dental offices, places you eat often, etc) Your time and efforts are needed to support our dancers, artistic staff, and company. Parents are required to volunteer (volunteer form enclosed). We also rely on you to spread community awareness of this production through sharing our information on social media (always tag us), handing out our flyers, and of course word of mouth.
